- The curriculum is designed for 7 years in 15 levels, based on North Indian classical musical standards.
- There are two semesters in each year: September to January and February to June.
- Each level offers up to 18 classes, one exam and performance opportunities based on evaluation.
- The classes are conducted once a week individual and/or in small groups.
- Individual class is for 45 minutes long and the group class is 60 minutes long.
- The schedule for each semester is fixed, it remains the same for the semester.
- Students must attend minimum 16 lessons to be eligible for the exams.
- Each student must pass the exam to move on to the next level.
- Respective teaches will make comments and suggestions during the evaluations.
- Student can fast track levels based on evaluation and teachers recommendation.

- There is a \$25.00 onetime non-refundable registration fee applicable only for the new student.
- There is a \$25.00 exam fee for external student.
- The fees must be paid within first month of the semester by cash or cheque payable to "Swar Sadhana".
- There will be a \$10.00 late fee applicable for each month delayed.
- The tax receipt will be provided for the amount paid within semester.
- In case student leaves the school permanently, the remainder of the fees will be refunded less the admin cost for termination.
- All the refund will be paid by cheque - (Ref: Refund).
- Additional presentation and performance fees applicable upon evaluation.

- We evaluate our students based on quality standards.

- Each evaluation will be communicated to parents via email and discussed in person, if necessary.
- New students with prior training will be evaluated to determine their starting level.
- Teachers may recommend a student to fast track couple of levels based on performance and evaluation.
